- Listen carefully to the extract from Samuel Coleridge Taylor's Clarinet Quintet (1:03). Describe the contour of this melody. [3] Ascending | Descending | Unchanging | Beginning | Middle | End
- Describe the difference in timbre between a clarinet playing high in its register and low down. [2] Rich | Shrill | Thin | Warm | Husky | Thick | Screaming | Lush
- 5. What is a slide between two notes called? [1]
